1. General Information

Ordering Instructions:

1. Obtain the following from the contractor, NC Correction Enterprises: NC Industrial Safety Prescription order forms, instruction sheets for the optometrics professional and descriptive literature. [Click Here](#) for Prescription Forms, Instructions and Frame Selection.
2. Employee takes prescription order form and instruction sheet to optical professional who fills out the Prescription order form. (Employee is responsible for cost of examination and fitting.)
3. Employee returns Prescription order form to unit Purchasing Office for processing.
4. "Ship to" address on purchase order shall be the employee's name c/o the optical professional's business address.

Note: Under no circumstances will spectacles purchased under the provisions of this contract be shipped directly to the employee. State agencies ordering spectacles should caution employees receiving spectacles to have prescription lenses, frame sizes and optional requirements verified by an authorized member of the optometric profession prior to wearing; otherwise, all responsibilities for any deleterious effects which may result from inaccurate compounding of the prescription or improper adjustment of the safety glasses will be disclaimed by the contractor.

If a quality level greater than that awarded is requested, the difference in cost will be the responsibility of the employee.

5. Purchase order must match the Prescription order form and must include:
 - a. One item type from Section A.
 - b. Any lens treatment options, Section B, if required by prescription.
 - c. Any frame accessory, Section C, D, & E, if required by prescription.
6. Signed Prescription order form (top copy) and purchase order are forwarded to the contractor.

Note: Multiple Prescription order forms may be pooled under a single purchase order.

7. Contractor will deliver finished safety glasses to the optical professional who will contact the employee and verify the prescription, check for proper adjustment and fit the glasses.
8. Note that occasionally **personal** doctor or optician will charge a fitting fee to new customers. This is an optional third party charge that is **NOT** covered in the contract, and is the responsibility of the individual. **However, per agreement with N.C. Correction Enterprises the only fee that Optometric Eye Care Providers will charge is a dispensing fee of \$10.00 per employee plus a reasonable exam fee. Note: If the eye exam is not performed by an Eye Care Provider, the dispensing fee will be \$30.00. The dispensing fee will only be \$10.00 if the employee gets his/her eye exam at the Optometric Eye Care Provider.**

2. Scope of Contract

The scope of this contract is limited to prescription safety spectacles with permanent sideshields. If there is not an Optometric Eye Care Provider in your area, you may call the N.C. Correction Enterprises Optical Plant at 1-888-388-1353 for a participation provider or you may opt out of this contract. Otherwise, you are expected to use this contract for all Prescription Safety Spectacle requirements

3. Taxes

Prices or Discounts shown herein do not include any North Carolina sales or use taxes.

4. Minimum Orders

This contract will be for a minimum order of \$25.00 for any single order. Agencies are authorized to purchase from best available sources on orders less than this minimum order value. This provision shall not be used by an agency to circumvent the intent of the contract. If an agency elects to place an order for less than the minimum order value, and the contractor elects to accept such order, then transportation charges will be prepaid and added to the invoice.

5. Placement of Orders

Orders will be placed throughout the contract period on an as-needed basis for the quantity required at the time, and will be issued directly to the respective contractor(s) or their designated suppliers. Contract changes, if any, over the life of the contract are implemented by contract addenda released by the Contract Administrator to the contractor. If the contractor is accepting orders and/or delivering through other parties, for example a manufacturer accepting orders and delivering through a dealer network or dealers receiving orders through a network of other dealers, then it is the responsibility of the contractor to apprise such parties of all such contract addenda.

6. Delivery

The contractor(s) will complete delivery within 20 consecutive calendar days after receipt of order. In the event the delivery is not received within the contract delivery period, the contractor may be held in default in accordance with paragraph 1, DEFAULT AND PERFORMANCE BOND in the North Carolina General Contract Terms and Conditions, and the state may procure the articles or services from other sources and hold the contractor responsible for excess cost occasioned thereby.

7. Transportation Charges

All goods shall be delivered FOB DESTINATION when the "order value" is \$25.00 or more, when shipped to a single destination. Orders to a single destination that total less than this "order value" should be shipped prepaid, with transportation charges added to the invoice as a separate item. Transportation charges invoiced for orders equal to or more than this "order value" may be cause for removal of the contractor from the contact.

NOTE: If the contractor makes partial shipments of an order equal to or more than this "order value" to one destination, all shipments of the order shall be sent FOB DESTINATION with NO additional transportation charges added.

Note! All shipments should be inspected for damage immediately upon receipt.

Addendum #7	<p>Attention: Optometric Eye Care Centers still charge a \$10 dispensing fee to state employees who receive their eye exams from them. For state employees who do not have their eye exams performed by Optometric Eye Care centers, there will be a dispensing fee of \$30 payable at the time of their fitting.</p> <p>All state employees must keep in mind that they do NOT have to go to OEC. If their own eye doctor can do the fitting of safety glasses that is OK. OEC has samples of all safety frames which makes it better for state employees and gives them more choices.</p> <p>Note: Correction Enterprise does not have control over other doctors as to what or how many sample frames they may have.</p> <p>This change is retroactive to January 1, 2009.</p>
